Tools:

Classroom lectures by experts, site visit to rain water harvesting projects in city, practical exercises by participant in designing of a model RWH scheme.

This 2 day training will equip participants with planning & designing skills of rain water harvesting for storing of rain water for direct use & Techniques for Ground water recharge.
