E-learning Course on "Water Footprint Assessment: towards sustainable and efficient water use" Organised by the Water Footprint Network

Period: 7-18 February 2011 Venue: Online

Water Footprint Network, together with the University of Twente of the Netherlands, is organizing an e-learning course on "Water Footprint Assessment: towards sustainable water resources management and effect water use". This on-line course (in English) will be delivered through WFN learning platform, combines online self-study modules with facilitated online discussion and Q&A with experts.

Objective: Introduce the concepts of water footprint and virtual water; discuss potential applications in water savings through trade; present why a business would want to conduct a corporate water footprint assessment, and how to do so.

Target group: Policy makers dealing with water management, agriculture and trade; corporate executives; academics; researchers; and those concerned with sustainable consumption of water resources.

Selection & Admission: Selection of participants will be done on a first-come-first-served basis. The final list of the selected participants will be announced through email by the Water Footprint Network ultimately by February 1, 2011.

Schedule: February 7-18, 2011, including a final quiz at the end of





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the course. Course schedule Jan. 28, 2011: Deadline for application Feb. 1, 2011: Finalize participant list and inform those who are accepted. Feb. 7, 2011: Course commencement Feb. 18, 2011: Course completion

Certificate: Participants who pass 80% of the final quiz before Feb. 18, 2011 will receive a certificate issued by the course organizers.

Course structure: The participants are required to go through the basic contents of the 4 modules by online self-study (2 hours). During the course, an online Q&A forum will be available for participants to raise questions directly to the experts and course facilitator. The optional discussion topics will be posted on the forum to lead participants to explore more contents and share their opinions with peers and experts. A topic will be posted every 2-3 days for participants to discuss.
