Please read the ENTRY GUIDELINES comprising of key information, before filling the Entry Form and submitting your entry.

The films thus identified will be shortlisted for screening in consultation with Ministry of Environment and Forests, Gol. The films shortlisted will be showcased during the festival.

CMS ENVIRONMENT – CATEGORY

Film that will be shortlisted for screening in the Biodiversity Film Festival will be one which highlights the role of biodiversity – forests, protected areas, biosphere reserves, mangroves, coral reefs, plant and animal biodiversity, genetic diversity, sustainable use and consumption of biodiversity, habitat degradation and protection, threats from invasive alien species, traditional knowledge and innovative practices - pertaining to biodiversity conservation; Such a film that can also provide an insight into the behaviour of animal(s) in its natural habitat, that revels information or throws new light into some aspect of it which is either new to the people or never filmed before.

CMS ENVIRONMENT – RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Rules and Regulations and Terms of Entry as, contained in this document, will govern the 'Biodiversity Film Festival' and will hereafter be referred to as the CMS Environment – Rules and Regulations. Please read the CMS Environment – Rules and Regulations carefully for submitting the entries.

Film entries must meet the following criteria:

QUALIFYING DATES

 Films must have been completed on or after January 1, 2008 and must carry a release date or copyright date or airdate during the calendar year 2008, 2009, 2010 or 2011.

DEADLINE

2. Final Deadline for receiving entries is May 10, 2011.

EXHIBITION COPY LANGUAGES

3. Entries are invited in all languages. Non-English and Non-Hindi language productions must include an English voiceover or subtitles.

EXHIBITION COPY FORMAT

4. Submit two 2 Exhibition copies in PAL DVD (region-free) format ONLY.

PRESS KIT AND FESTIVAL DIRECTORY

- Please include HIGH RESOLUTION still photographs (JPEG, TIF or EPS formats). The following will be required for the press kit and Festival Directory;
 - (i) Production stills (5);
 - (ii) Director's photograph (2);

All the above to be sent by email or in a CD-ROM along with the duly filled form and other required enclosures.

DELIVERY

- 6. All materials must be sent prepaid. Collect or C.O.D. (Cash on Delivery) will not be accepted.
- 7. CMS Environment will not assume responsibility or accept shipments incurring expenses for terminal charges, duties, taxes or custom brokerage.

CREDIT

- 8. Names on the Credit roll must match with those in the Entry Form.
- Entries can be submitted by the producer, co-producer, commissioner, broadcaster, director or an entrant (individual/ organization) who has the right to submit the entry.

GENERAL

- 10. Films may be of any length.
- 11. Films may be of genre documentary, fiction or non-fiction.
- 12. Entrant may submit more than one film
- 13. CMS Environment will not be responsible for any loss or damage to any films. All films and related materials may be insured by the entrant against any damage or loss which may occur during transit or in the course of the festival.
- 14. CMS reserves the right to exclude films which are not in conformity with aims of the Festival or produced in ways which does not respect living creatures, their behaviour and habitats.
- The screening committee of the Festival will decide the composition of the events, protocol and screening schedules of the Festival.
- 16. Exhibition copies submitted to the Festival will not be returned and will be a part of the CMS Environment archives. Please do not submit originals (original DVD, original tape, print photographs etc).

- 17. The films submitted in the Biodiversity Festival will be included in other non-commercial and educational public screenings around the world by CMS Environment.
- 18. Please preview your entries before shipping. Programs with time code or other defects may be disqualified.
- Please thoroughly review the Festival- Rules and Regulations, Category Information and Entry Form included in this booklet.
- 20. CMS has the right to change any information contained in this document (including festival dates, venues, events, awards and eligibility requirements) without further notice.
- 21. Submission of entries implies full acceptance of the CMS Enviornment – Rules and Regulations, Guidelines and Terms of Entry
- 22. All matters regarding the Festival will be decided by the Festival Director and her decision in these matters shall be final.
- 23. All matters not mentioned in these regulations will be decided by the Festival Director. The discretion to make an exception to any rules and regulations of the festival will rest with the Festival Director.
- 24. All disputes are subjected to the exclusive jurisdiction of competent courts and forums in Delhi only.
