Minimum Requirements: Advanced university degree in the social/behavioural sciences (Sociology, Anthropology, Psychology, Health Education, Communication) with emphasis on participatory communication, communication planning, social mobilization, participatory research, training and impact evaluation of communication interventions. Minimum five years progressively responsible work experience in the planning and management of social development programmes, with practical experience in the adaptation and application of communication planning processes to specific programmes, especially sanitation and hygiene.
