The Workshop will be attended by organizations and individuals working on rivers, streams and hydrological issues in the Central Himalayan regions of the country, in particular from Uttarakhand and Himachal Pradesh. Resource persons and experts will also attend the Workshop from various parts of the country.

A Primer on the What, Why and How of environmental flows, authored by Dr. Latha Anantha (River Research Centre, Kerala) and Parineeta Dandekar (South Asia Network on Dams, Rivers and People, SANDRP) has been published by International Rivers and will also be shared with participants during the workshop.
