INSTRUCTIONS:

- a. An applicant for the Senior Fellowship should not have availed of Senior Fellowship under any of the fields. The candidates who have availed of Junior Fellowship earlier and intend to apply for the Senior Fellowships can apply only if there is a gap of five years from the date of completion of their Junior Fellowship. An applicant for the Junior Fellowship should not have availed of Junior Fellowship under any of the fields. The candidates who have availed of scholarship under the Scheme for Scholarship for Young Artistes of the Ministry of Culture and intend to apply for the Junior fellowships can apply only if there is a gap of five years from the date of completion of their scholarship.
- b. If the applicants are employed in the Central/State Government Departments/Institutions/Undertaking/University, UGC-aided colleges etc., they will have to take leave for a period of two years if selected for the grant of Fellowship. They should submit their fellowship applications through the Head of the Department/Institution/Undertaking/University, etc. with the written assurance that in case the fellowship is sanctioned, the candidate would be granted leave for the duration of the Fellowship. The first instalment of fellowship will be released on production of proof of leave sanctioned, in addition to fulfillment of other conditions as applicable.
- c. An Expert-Committee comprising experts in different fields will be constituted by the Ministry of Culture, Government of India, which would in the first stage examine all applications and shortlist the most meritorious among them for eventual selection of the required number of Fellows in different fields/areas.
- d. Shortlisted Junior Fellowship candidates will be called for an interview/talk by the Expert Committee who will then select the most meritorious candidates upto the required number of Junior Fellowships in different fields/areas. No such interview/talk may however, be necessary in the case of Senior Fellowships.
- e. In case of plastic arts, photographs of the applicant's six different works should be appended with the application.
- f. Books/brochures/cassettes MUST NOT BE SENT.
- g. Applicants are encouraged to visit Ministry's **website : www.indiaculture.nic.in** and see full details of the Scheme.
- h. Incomplete applications will be rejected.
- i. All awards sanctioned under the Scheme shall be disbursed by the Central Government directly.
