- 2. A research abstract (800 words maximum documents exceeding maximum word limit will not be processed). This abstract must focus on a specific country situation or country analysis AND/OR on one of the following topics:
 - Gender and Equity how gender (in)equalities are embedded in and reinforced by water governance
 - Water conflicts conflicts may derive from mis-allocation of water, scarcity, political reasons, vested interests, resource crunch, geo-political causes, compromised regulatory mechanism; etc.
 - WASH How lack of integrity affects WASH progress
 - Technology low cost technology that empowers citizens and give them direct control over the resource
 - Water allocation Allocation of water is based on non-transparent and nonequal processes and priority needs. Focus on how water is allocated bypassing integrity issues
 - Accountability in the water sector enabling environments for effective accountability in the water sector

The selection process will assign:

- 4/10 points for relevance of CV
- 6/10 points for quality of abstract
- Selection criteria will prioritize on participants from the countries indicated on the Global Call.
