## **Job Purpose**

The Manager Technical support is responsible for developing and rolling out policies related to WASH technologies, Water Quality and Hygiene and ensuring standards and policy adherence in all projects and programmes. Will lead on the technical skill mapping and capacity building of partners, and support teams to implement technical works. Contribute to the strengthening of the WaterAid India's Program in Urban Areas. Functionally manage the Technical Officers in the region and liaise with external organisations. The post holder will work as a member of the country management team.

## **Key Accountabilities:**

- Be responsible for developing, updating and operationalising policies and guidelines on WASH technologies in line with WAI values and guiding principles
- Provide effective technical support with appropriate and inclusive technologies and designs
- Provide technical supervision and oversight on adherence to standards to all WAI programmes and projects
- Support developing and operationalising WaterAid India's urban strategy and lead in the areas of City Sanitation Plans, and affordable, adequate and accessible community managed technical options
- Lead, manage, and develop technical officers/group in their roles to maximise their contribution to programme efficiency.
- Review proposals of partner projects to determine fit with standards in relation to technical aspects, and develop a map of technologies in WAI programmes and their effectiveness
- Engage with key stakeholders and contribute to internal and external policy discourse on policy issues related to technologies.
- Foster innovations and encourage learning to effectively contribute to the technology gaps and needs
  of the programme and of the sector.
- Lead maintenance of technical resource database of expert individuals and institutions that can support in capacity building and advisory roles.
- Ensure that measures are in place in all projects especially those that involve construction according to health and safety policy for construction projects.
- Develop regular briefs, reports and papers, and contribute to communications and publications on technology,

- Ensure reasonable care is taken of self and others in the workplace (including team members managed if appropriate) according to health and safety policy and principles.
- Undertake any other responsibilities, tasks or activities as reasonably required.
